



A small, circular tank filled with water, a mini mantapam set inside and a mini teppam that moves all around it, is a draw for devotees and more, for children visiting the temple now.

The celebration signals the break of spring, but here, it is the summer season and a time to symbolically offer a cool atmosphere to the gods.

The first section of the utsavam is focussed on lord Kapali, then on lord Singaravelar. Odhuvars recite the sacred verses and deeparadhanai is performed in the evening.




Annual Day of nursery, primary schools

220 children participated in this event and many presented a vibrant show based on theme "Enchanting Tamil Nadu"

















VINCENT'S JOTTINGS

Chara brought us two stories from her home zone.

One was of a woman who sold snacks in the evening on a *mada* street. She had put up a stall for the *panguni utsavam* of Sri Kapali Temple in Mylapore, sold well and the sales encouraged her to stay put.

So I sent her on another assignment - to capture the mood of the Vasanta utsavam at Sri Kapali Temple. She said she found kids throwing coins into the miniature tank set in the temple premises, and making wishes. Most of them asked that they score well in their exams.

Vihaan spotted a group of women at their annual summer service. They pooled money, made lines of buttermilk and shared it with passers-by and workers at the street junction of their colony.

Laya was quick to locate a place where a team re-packed organic food stuff, like pulses and oils, grown and cycled in farms in the outbacks and sold in this part of the city.

There was only that much we could do at the 12-day Journalism Camp that I hosted at the *Mylapore Times*. But the school students who got into it, seemed to have picked up some soft skills that will hold good as they move up in life.

We had some good learnings when we took a walk down a *mada* street one evening - looking at *keerai* and flower hawkers, a priestess and a less-abled kitchen goods hawker, we looked at leftovers of old-time gardens of bungalows and little doors in large houses which were the 'use this only' for maids and cleaners.

I assume some of our participants would have enjoyed another week or more of the Camp. But they had other considerations on hand; some, leftovers of school academics, some competitions and some back-to-school work.

Teens in our schools are certainly not getting the experience they should at this stage and age. For this new world. They are cogs in a wheel that is suffocating, more of the same and dumbing down.

The Socials or Civics lessons for seniors in the last leg of academic year should have made space for India's elections. The time to learn what our elections are all about, and the role citizens play in them. Ending with a mock poll in the classroom.

And there are many skills that teens need to learn. How do you talk to people? How do you ferret information? How do you look at an issue, the little world around you, the happening in your backyard? How do you take down notes? How do you present a report? How do you write or express yourself?

My Mom, Sudharani Raghupathy

"Can do better"

These words resonate in my circumambience when I try to catch the earliest recollection of my childhood having my mother in the midst and my school, Vidya Mandir, Mylapore, as the proscenium of this memory.

Least did I know that she was of such eminence, most highly respected as a Bharatanatyam dancer and then, a guru.

It was the usual Parent-Teacher Assn. meeting at school where the teachers used to give a condensed report of the student's performance, both academics and otherwise for the entire year, both the report card and the lips of the teacher used to mime the words "Can do better"!

Until the age of 15, I looked anaemic and

my mother was in the habit of feeding me, usually lunch. It was by some miracle that I did not choke over the morsels stuffed down in quick succession. Amma was very strict and wanted me to do well in school academically.

She thought I was better without the distractions of any form of the fine arts or sneaking into her dance school, Shree Bharatalaya (on Luz Church Road).

She used to monitor my movement like a hawk and only later did I know that a retired deputy superintendent of police (DSP) had warned her that I would make a brilliant criminal if I was not watched and guided properly! He said this when I was 8 years old and to this day I still believe that she has a third eye!

Childhood at our home was very disciplined. Amma used to run the household and take care of all domestic needs of the family, run her school of fine arts in our premises and also juggle her professional dance career.

Then came the hijack! It was 1993 January. Suddenly there was a call from the then Dir. General of Doordarshan, Shashikanth Kapoor, informing my father that Amma's flight from Delhi was hijacked by a terrorist and redirected to Pakistan. I had never heard the word "hijack" before in my life. Of course she came back safe.

The hijack episode had a profound and lasting impact on me. I was a completely changed personality and from then on I took up several household responsibilities and also started assisting the family in administrative errands.

Now, three decades later, as we (me and my mother) take a stroll on Luz Avenue every day, I attribute the discipline, skills acquired and the fulfilment in my life to the strict task master that my mother is, with her grace and affection.

At the same time, her natural *abhinaya* comprising fear, anxiety and concern, to elicit the rasa of *vaatsalyam*, "Can do Better"

A tree on St. Mary's Road is posing a serious danger to MTC buses and private lorries. It protrudes on to the main road


On a recent morning, a nasty accident to a bus caused limited damage. A MTC bus on route number 21G was proceeding from TTK Road to St. Marys Road.

Opposite St Francis Xavier's School gate, there was a barricade on the right side of the road to facilitate painting of zebra crossing, so the bus driver took the extreme right hand side of the road and in doing so, the bus hit a large branch of a tree and a section of the roof of the bus was ripped off.

The bus was stopped and the passengers were asked to get down and take another bus.

Local residents say they have complained to Chennai Corporation of the need to either trim the tree or chop it down but action has not been forthcoming.




unstitched chudidhar material and kurtis as well. We also sell inner wear for both men and women," says Chandrasekar P. K., who has been in this business for 40 years.


A huge number of voters voted at the booths here that Friday. This included the




