

VINCENT's JOTTINGS

The four, decorated, coloured candles placed near the altar for Advent Holy Mass at the San Thome Cathedral last Sunday had me thinking.

Is there a Christmas-land in our city?

Is there an area where I could get a sense of this festival if I were to merely walk up and down some of the streets here?

That evening, I asked Shan Eugene, a Stella Maris College lecturer in the department of history and tourism, who resides in Madhavaram, what Christmas was like in that area. And

she had lots to tell me.

Perambur, once the big hub of
Anglo Indians, was Christmasland in
the decades gone by. Over time, many
people who resided here moved to
Madhavaram and beyond. Apartments
and houses were cheaper to buy or
to rent. Among them were many
Christians of various denominations.



In their new hearths, these families celebrated Christmas the way they have always done in the past.

The early preparations are often in three parts and they start after the boxes which hold all the Christmas needs are taken out from the storage spaces.

First up is the Christmas tree - some may have a tree that is just two feet tall, some may have a tree they sourced from the Gulf or from Singapore, a big one. Decorating the tree is an art by itself and illuminating it has become a tad easy, now that the market offers a multitude of bulbs and serial sets of all kinds.

Next up, is the crib which symbolises the scenes of the birth of Jesus. For children, the engaging part of making the crib is debating how it must be designed - much depends on space. Can we create a grassland that leads to rugged hillsides? How do we create a skyline and have stars across it? Can we use recycled paper and board too?

Much of all this is akin to the way families create theme sets around the Navaratri Kolu!

Finally, comes the decoration of the drawing room and the spaces outside the apartment or the house.

Shaan told me that many families had started putting up the decorations and that if I came by after Christmas eve, her area would be the Christmasland I was thinking of.

In our childhood years, Moore Market was the Christ-masland in this city. Now, I hope I can go around Madhavaram to experience something different.

Would you be putting up a Christmas star on the balcony or above the porch?

Woes of users of Post Offices of Mandaveli and R. A. Puram

The entry to the R. A. Puram Post Office situated in R. K. Mutt Road is jam packed with parked vehicles. Also, the post box which is located on the right side of the entrance is not easily accessible - with parked vehicles, a tall pavement / platform and an awfully stinking public garbage bin bang in front of the post box. Sometimes, the bin overflows with garbage effectively blocking the approach to the post box.



This post office is very popular and patronized by senior citizens because the operations take place in the ground floor and operations start at 9 am.

The Mandaveli Post Office, even though close to residents of this area, is far from accessible to the elderly because

it operates from the first floor onwards and the steps are too steep for the elderly and the disabled to climb. Postal authorities should address all these issues keeping in mind the needs of its clients.

On December 20 & 21 at R. R. Sabha



The Lakshminarayana Global Music Festival (LGMF), one of India's longest-running and prestigious festival celebrating global music, returns with its 35th edition in Chennai on December 20 and 21 at R. R. Sabha, Mylapore. The festival will be inaugurated by R. N. Ravi, governor of Tamil Nadu on Dec. 20.

Founded by well-known violinist Dr. L. Subramaniam in 1992 in memory of his father and guru, Prof. V. Lakshminarayana, this fest has had performances in 30 countries.



MYLAPORE SOCIAL HISTORY

Life in one part of R. A. Puram in the 1960s

'Old student' Yamuna who studied in Rani Meyyammai Girls' High School in the 1960s rewinds to that era.

It was a hot summer's day in July 1964. We had just moved from Mambalam to a housing complex located at Ramakrishna Nagar, Raja Annamalai Puram, Chennai, Tamil Nadu 600028.

When the Tamil Nadu Housing Board started constructing here, the plan was to build 10 MIG (Middle Income Group) buildings with 60 flats and 3 LIG (Low Income Group) buildings with 18 flats. There were detached garages available for sale with the flat and a lot of space for playgrounds.





We were in one of the first built buildings and there was a lot of empty space where other buildings were slowly coming up. There were no gates, and everything was wide open. My brothers used to play cricket in the playground. I learnt my bicycling in that summer on my own. Later, the colony, as we used to call it, was fenced in with gates on both sides for entry and exit, with a security guard posted here.

Most of the people living in the colony belonged to the middle to upper middle class sections. There were a few single-family bungalow style gated homes as well in the neighborhood.

Thiruveedhi Amman Temple was a prominent landmark. A few years later, around that area new buildings without indoor water plumbing were put up by the government, to house poor families. The road leading from the colony to Venkatakrishna Road became waterlogged sometimes - because of poor sanitation. The Buckingham Canal added another dimension to the neighborhood. The closest hospital was Andhra Mahila Sabha's hospital where my brother was born. There were no other hospitals in this area. Today, that R.K. Nagar colony is no more - the old buildings have been demolished, and new ones like Ragamalika Apartments have been built by L& T company.

Joining a new School

I had finished my 8th standard and was looking forward to joining the new school in the new neighborhood. With all the unoccupied space, it was a straight five-minute walk from our house! At that time the school was called "The Girls' High School, R. A. Puram".

My father took me to the new school to meet with the principal (HM), Mrs. Saraswathi Srinivasan. She asked me my name, what my special interests were and my favorite subject and a few other questions. I mumbled something and was admitted to the ninth standard. That was it!

No entrance exam, no test, no donation, nothing! Compared to what one must go through

to secure admission in a school nowadays, it felt like I was entitled to an education!

The school had one main concrete yellow building where the HM had her office, and the rest were all classrooms with thatched roofs where most of my classes were held.

There were no lights or fans in the thatched rooms. We were learning under natural surroundings and all classes were conducted during the daylight time. I think there were about 40 kids in my class. We all sat on rows of long wooden benches. The medium of instruction was either Tamil or English. All English medium

students were in "A" section and the rest of us belonged to B, C or D section.

A majority of the students were middle class Hindu kids. A few Christians and Muslims added diversity to the student body. There was no intrafaith tension then and I don't think anyone really cared about the religion of other kids. If there was, it was not palpable.

Classes under Trees

Occasionally, we had science classes under the big trees – my favorite place. Once a squirrel jumped into one of the girl's skirt and she was seen running amok, terrified. Laughter aside, it was a memorable scene that stayed with me - even to this day!

The school was a progressive institution, celebrating all holidays irrespective of religion. We had Thai style candle dances for Diwali, Thiruppavai bhajans, and Christmas carols in Tamil. I remember waiting in line to get a piece of the Christmas cake. We also studied Seerapuranam, a Muslim

literature depicting the biography of the prophet.

We celebrated other holidays as well - such as the Independence Day and the Republic Day when the whole school assembled in front of the HM's office. The student leader would hoist the Indian flag, and we sang the National anthem. After the HM's speech, we got candies and went home.

Children's day was special too. All school children used to assemble in the playground, and we listened to speeches about Jawaharlal Nehru and his childhood. As a newly elected literary and debating association secretary, I had to give my first impromptu speech in front of about 500 kids about Ne hru! I had no idea what I was saving!

Sports day was full of competitions - in net ball, javelin, discus throw, tennikoit, throw ball and a few others. Annual days were celebrated with entertainment including some plays, music performances, and dances after which there were a lot of awards and certificates for the best students in each subject category. As a Tamil afficionado, I got one for Tamil every year. We also had some literary competitions including reciting a few chapters from Bhagavad Gita, essays on Bharathiyar etc.

Civic Pride: support for Indian Army

My introduction to politics and civic pride was in 1965 I think, when we took part in a parade rallying support for the Indian military against Pakistan at that time. I remember that my teacher assembled a group of us from the school, bused us to some place where we joined girls from other schools, and we were all parading and shouting slogans like "Death to Ayub Khan".

The school was egalitarian. Uniforms - a long maroon skirt, white blouse, and a half sari - were mandatory. Younger kids wore similar uniforms too but without the half sari. Ours

was a Higher Secondary school (grades 6 through 11). We had no elementary school students. 11th grade was completed after taking and passing the SSLC (Secondary School Licensing Certificate) exam, equivalent to high school graduation.

Many of us went ahead to do PUC (Pre-University Course) in a college after which the 3-year BA/BSc. or professional degree programs started.

We had students from all economic backgrounds from the nearby areas including R.A Puram, Adyar and Mandaveli. One of my classmates was from a low-income family living in a nearby hut! I also knew some of my friends were living in big bungalows. The school had a bare ground for a gym! But we had a net for playing netball, just outside the HM's office and a lot of open space for throw ball, tennikoit and a few tag games.

My favorite subject was Tamil. I strongly believe that my values and attitudes were formed and solidified because of the progressive school environment and the Tamil poems we were assigned to read including Nanmanikkatigai, Bharathiyar poems and Silappadhikaram.

One specific quote by Arya Padai Kadandha Nedunchezjian in Tamil was etched in my mind and was the harbinger of what my life was going to be. He said, "An educated person transcends status. Even if you belong to a disadvantaged community, if you are a scholar, even the king will listen to your counsel". I heeded his advice and got my higher education in India and then some in the United States where I've been living for the past four decades

Most of my friends came from middle-class sections like me and we really didn't have any tight money issues per se or never really talked about it. Since our house was so close to the school, a lot of my friends came with me to our house to have lunch and play with my little brother who was only a year old. Everyone brought their own lunch except for one girl who never brought her lunch. My mom always fed her and none of us ever asked her why she never had her own lunch, or if she had money issues at home.

The one student I mentioned who lived in a hut, whom I visited much later after graduation, had already married, and had a child as well. She was just fifteen! I was devastated to see that the child had bowed legs, probably due to lack of proper pre-natal nutrition. After joining college, I lost touch with her although I think about her and her situation often.

The goal of becoming a doctor or an engineer was a constant even then. Just like computer science is the profession everyone now wants to get into; in my days getting a job in a bank was a dream come true. Since getting into a medical school proved elusive, I was the odd one wanting to become a scientist, which I pursued and became one, much to the chagrin of my father who wanted me to become a bank officer.

One of my friends became a doctor and she is doing exemplary volunteer work within the community. Another one went to a bank and became an officer. I learnt later that one of our friends died of a rare blood disorder a few years after she left school.

Since I learnt biking, I used to rent a bike from the nearby cycle repair shop after school and go to my friend's house close by. Either we used to just hang around or study for the next test. I had classical music lessons after school so that took a big slice of my time as well.

Life in R. K. Nagar

The R.K. Nagar colony was like a microcosm and a world of its own. After all the buildings were built in a few years and fully occupied, everyone knew almost everyone, and it was a growing community with its own life revolving around the occupants and their lives. Windows were always open, and one could hear if any big function was going on somewhere in the building.

In a typical middle class Brahmin family, most of our lives revolved around home, extended relatives, friends, and family. We teens had no money of our own. With zero purchasing power, not much shopping could be done, no TV to watch, and no cell phone for social media - unlike today! My sisters who are a few years younger remind me that they had more of a social life - going to eat out with friends after window shopping! Luz Corner and Sri Kapali Temple tank were some of the favourite places to hang out with friends for some people.


Some of my uncles and aunts lived in the Mambalam area at that time and some still do. Extended relatives used to drop by anytime unannounced and were always well received. No need to call ahead or make plans and no one was complaining! Well, maybe not to their face. Kapaleeswarar Temple was one of the favorite places to visit although those days the surrounding area was not kept as clean as today. On the tank's sides were street vendors, selling produce and was the most visited place during religious festivities for shopping.

Then there was Foreshore Estate which was treated as a garbage dumping ground in the sixties. Kamadhenu and Kabali theaters were the landmarks in Mandaveli, and I remember seeing a few movies with my mom. For a few paise, kids could sit on the floor in front of the big screen and people who could afford a bit more paid more and got to sit on chairs in the back. All movies ended with the Indian national anthem.

STORIES OLD PHOTOS HOLD

Old photographs hold many little stories. And this one does.

This photo, shot from the south side of the Chitrakulam, was shared by heritage buff Parantharami Mani some weeks ago. This former commissioner, ESIC, Govt. of India and a resident of Justice Sundaram Road keeps digging into the Net to locate and share photos and notes on 'old' Madras.

So what does this photo tell us? Would it have been shot in the 1960s?

The steps of the temple look irregular; perhaps they were not restored over time then?

Very stark though is the quiet Chitrakulam north street, very few people seen . . . and a clear view of the tank from that side, as it was from all other sides.

Today, over a dozen bunk shops hug the tank's edge and make walking and driving a task.

The buildings on this street survive. One notable place here was a Mylai Commercial Institute, popular in Mylapore.

It offered classes in typewriting, shorthand and accountancy. It survived till about a year ago - its old signboard remains on the first floor today.

The photo shows a giant

tree and a statue of Gandhiji (today, the statue is in a large enclosure). There are a few trees here today but the area is a hawkers zone. This statue was formally opened in 1970 by the then Congress leader K. Kamaraj.

Beyond, you spot the south end of East Mada Street; it still had tiled houses. Recalls Mani. "I used to pass by this area almost daily in my school and college years."

At one end, was the well-known Band Box laundry.

It was then patronised by the well-off Mylaporeans to get their pattu saris and silks, costly trousers and coats washed and dry-cleaned.

Further up, was Burma Stores, a popular provisions store. It is said it was managed by a Burma refugee.

The buildings of what must be inside the campus of Lady Sivaswamy Ayyar Girls School can also be seen across the 'kulam'.

One cannot miss the cycle-rickshaws at one corner - they were a popular mode of transport over short distances for Mylaporeans.
