When V. Sundararajan spots large pieces of packing material or thick thermocole lying around, his eyes light up, his fingers twitch. He forms ideas and slowly gets to work.

91 years old, this retired mechanical engineer who worked for Dunlop India, has always had a creative side. Creating simple crafted works engages him.

It is a skill he has developed over the years. Often, his wife joins him at the table.

Recently, Sundararajan located a large cardboard box which was leftover packing material for a dining table the family had ordered. He set to work on this.

He ended up making a replica of the moolavar Perumal and Thayar, the images you will find at Sri Varadaraja Perumal Temple in Kancheepuram.



















VINCENT's JOTTINGS

I enjoy listening to the music of falling rain.

It helps that the window of my ground floor apartment looks out into an open space where two trees form a leafy umbrella. As you can imagine, the raindrops take on different tones when they drop off the leaves. And other sounds, like the crash of cymbals, roll when water falls on the metal sheets

somebody has dumped behind the trees.

When it begins to rain after ten at night, the music gently puts you to sleep. And though I cannot leave the windows wide open at monsoon time, the music of the rain has a way of slipping in.

On Saturdays, I can get a tad anxious.

For, my thoughts are with the *Mylapore Times* newspaper. That morning is circulation time and you can imagine the problems our team has to negotiate on a rainy day.

Water can reduce newspapers to wet bagasse in minutes! The van delivers the newspaper bundles around 5.30 a.m.

Our newspaper gets printed in the wee hours of the morning, at a printing press that is some 40kms from the city centre. A van takes less than an hour to transport the bundles to the main printing press in the city, from where a van we hire, brings the copies to our office in Alwarpet.

At monsoon time, the roadside floods, and the mess is compounded because a drain system is absent on this side of the wide, busy road. Plus, local food and tea shops happily drain the waste water into public space.

So we have to make sure that the bundles are unloaded onto dry space and then, copies handed over to the circulation boys.

Circulating newspapers in the rain is a tough task. We cannot ask the boys to delay the task because they have to report for daily work elsewhere. What they earn here is not big money. And negotiating water-logged inner streets is a difficult task.

Reason why I pray and hope there is a break in the rain on Saturdays at the break of dawn. So the boys can double up in that window and get the job done. Circulating a free newspaper has its challenges and we have to deal with readers' complaints and get our act right every week.

Retaining boys for this work is just not easy. Boys are always looking for the bucks elsewhere. They were enamoured by the jobs that food delivery services promised but now that they know the money isn't all that great, they look elsewhere. Perhaps, what keeps them with us is that the job is very local and only once a week. And we take care of them and offer support when they are in a corner.

Newspaper circulation work all around us is shrinking. Because people have stopped subscribing to the dailies. And small newspapers have stopped engaging agents and agents have stopped hiring boys. The math doesn't work out for them.

In Goa, the neighbourhood agent stocks the newspapers at his home, with your name on it and you must hop across and pick it up - do it at your convenience. Or you must travel to the few books / stationery stores that stock daily / weekend newspapers and buy a copy.

To our readers who have trouble getting a copy of *Mylapore Times* on Saturday, we suggest they check out the E-paper that is posted by 9 am on Saturday. But most people want a hard copy. Nothing like a newspaper in one hand and a cup of tea or coffee in the other!

From Tamil. To French. At Queen Marys

It was in 1997 that I first walked into Queen Marys College, transfer order in hand. 27 years is a long time to accumulate memories, experiences, lessons and friendships!

Queen Marys is the only government college in Tamil Nadu that offers French. Too often, one associates French with fashionably dressed teachers having bobbed hair and stylish, confident students getting out of sleek limousines.

Nothing could be further from reality at QMC. Here, its is all about Vive l'Inde - en français! Indian identity is never lost, nor Indian culture, certainly not the mother tongue! As for the students, uninitiated they may be about haute couture or Ratatouille, but the learning process has no barriers when motivation is strong. 'Pluie du matin n'arrete pas le pèlerin!'

No joy can equal that of observing our students, grow and glow. These girls are daughters of auto drivers, housemaids, gas cylinder delivery men, some alcoholics, and single parents... the list is endless. Many of these young girls, from Tamil medium schooling background, defy all odds to go ahead to pursue a life with the French language.

What greater pride than watching your students work as college French teachers themselves, or in multinationals, many abroad, who all come back to their alma mater, radiant with the satisfaction

of achievement.

I recall with special pride my student of English literature (many years ago) whose family scoffed at her decision to opt for an MA in French and later wept with pride when she boarded the plane to Paris, on an exchange programme, the first flier in the family, who actually brought home her earnings to fund her sister's marriage.

Many students of course may not take French or even pursue academics after their degree. Nonetheless, all of them are in a much better place than when they entered the portals of this grand 109 year old institution. They make our hearts burst with pride.

The girls I taught 27 years ago are themselves greying, dignified mothers now. (What about us then!) Many remain in touch, many have now qualified as friends, and not just on Facebook! They've grown... and with them, we too.

DEATH OF FISH IN TEMPLE TANK: HOW DID IT HAPPEN?

Hundreds and hundreds of fish were found dead and floating in the waters of the tank of Sri Kapaleeswarar Temple in Mylapore. Last Monday, workers used barges and nets to clear all the dead fish.

In 24 hours, the water in the tank looked clear,

the scene serene.

What caused the death of fish?

Mylapore MLA Dha Velu, who visited the spot on Monday, told the media that the death must have been caused by the oil poured into hundreds of lamps placed on the steps of the tank for Karthikgai Deepam, flowing into the water after it rained. But volunteers at the tank say that the dead fish were seen floating in the south west corner of the tank from 5 pm onwards when it had not rained yet. They contested the MLA's stand.

Others say that the water that flowed into

the tank from this point, where the outlet from local drains is located (the inner tank area opposite Sangeetha restaurant) was dirty and smelly on Sunday evening and that may have caused the fish to die.

The rainwater that had

flowed the previous rainy days had only been part muddy.

A few others say that the variation in oxygen levels in the water due to steady rainwater inflow into the tank can also cause death of fish.

Mylapore Times' photographer who had peeped into the tank on Karthigai Deepam evening (Sunday) said he noticed a few dead fish in one corner. But when he returned to check if the lamps had been lit for Deepam, he saw workers trying to clear hundreds of dead fish.

HR & CE officials at the temple have sent the fish and water for lab tests and await results.

For many years now, the tank's periphery has been well-barricaded, the gates shut and watchmen guard the area. People are not even allowed into it at some spaces for rituals.

FATE OF FISH

There are a few species of fish which thrive in the temple tank. They have been reared over many years now. They have also been harvested.

But it is not clear if harvesting of the fish is done on a regular, proper basis.

Temple officials said that only one species of the fish died in the thousands.

Samples of the dead fish and water have been sent to reputed laboratories for tests. Readings of those results will provide some pointers to the cause of the death of sealife.

The water level has been rising steadily since this monsoon broke out.

CHENNAI METRO: ALL SET FOR MAJOR TRAFFIC **MOVEMENT CHANGES**

Major, multiple traffic movement changes in the Mylapore region's streets and roads will come into effect this Sunday, December 3. But if the weather is bad then this plan will be pushed back a bit.

These changes are being made to facilitate major works of Chennai Metro, which is building two rail lines in Phase 2 of the project that will serve this zone - one that runs east – west and one that runs north – south.

Areas of Royapettah High Road, Luz, Mylapore, Abiramapuram, R A Puram, Mandaveli and Alwarpet will see traffic movement diversion changes

On Friday evening, an official of Chennai Metro and local area police officials met a small group of Mylaporeans at a private petrol bunk in Mandaveli to share details

of the changes that will follow and listen to issues presented by a few civic-minded Mylaporeans.

Said Baskar Seshadri who attended this meet, "We told the officials that diverting buses and vans into narrow and busy streets like Thiruvengadam Street and Venkatesa Agraharam was not a wise move."

Chennai Metro officials have said that they will study the effect of the changes and promised further changes based on feedback.

They told the participants that they had studied traffic patterns in the zone and dropped some measures and had to go ahead with some.

The past week's monsoon has caused some problems across Mylapore zone. Some colonies have faced serious issues. In many cases, civic body staff have been quick to respond and address issues.

Here are some key notes

● The big mess continues in the P. S. Sivaswami Salai - Royapettah High Road region. Flooding takes place, sewage overflows, the zone stinks. Mylapore's MLA was seen directing SOS measures; he did the same when it flooded months ago. The real problem - alignment of sew-

age and drain lines in this zone and area off Sanskrit College area is not properly done. Core issues not addressed.

- Potholes show up starkly when it rains. C. P. Koil Street, Mandaveli Street, Alamelumangapuram, St. Mary's Road. These are streets/ roads that have not been re-laid for a long time.
- Is the barricading of Chennai Metro work zones leading to flooding too? Mandaveli MTC bus terminus zone was flooded, water seen oozing out of drains and running into South Canal Bank Road.
- •All the temple tanks are full or almost full.
 Aided by proper harvesting systems. But in some, waste runs in and pollutes this water.


