Once Shorthand, now only Typewriting

As I passed along Kutchery Road, a route I travel almost daily, I stopped to look at a white building that bore two signboards, the most prominent one reading,

"The Shorthand School (Established 1909)."

Stepping inside the foyer, I noticed a spiral staircase, leading

in 1909 by Srikantan Iyer, originally to teach shorthand - a highly sought-after skill at the time.

Over the years, typewriting and accountancy were added to the curriculum.

Today, the school is under the proprietorship of the founder's grandson, B. Padmanabhan. Parvathi said that the family had lived on the premises since the 1930s, when the school also moved to its current location.

> She recalled an era when British officials, professionals, and even notable personalities attended classes there to master shorthand and typing.

The school discontinued teaching shorthand in 2008 due to dwindling interest. Typewriting, however, remains in demand.

In here, were 25 typewriting stations, including three

designated for Tamil typing.

Padmanabhan himself conducts the classes. Twelve batches are run daily from 6 a.m., each session lasting 45 minutes.



Canteens at bus and train stations are a life. Part of a passage, or a break. And the menu card said so much about people's preferences and wants.

I mean, having enjoyed a fish curry-rice for 100 bucks, I'd want to have extra curry for just 20 to polish off the rice!

This took my mind to George's restaurant in Panjim where friends had hosted a lunch: I lifted the plate of fish curry to my mouth and consumed it, wiping my lips with my tongue, like a

Any food joint is a man-watching world. If you care to take your eyes off your plate and look around. I do this often in Mylapore though my go-to place has been Vasantham, for its quiet and the allowance for people like us to work, write a story, edit, mail. . .

Sometimes I am at Nithya Amirtham on an evening and as I enjoy a light tiffin I look around. A family has brought the kids here, for tiffin, after school and a wash. The girl is breaking down the dosa pyramid, the boy has something Chinese and the mother tries to steal some from her son's plate as he looks away!

I have tried to sit still at that Udupi joint on North Mada Street (cannot get its name just now). Take the seat just off the pavement, turn towards the street and enjoy life outside as I enjoy a cup of coffee.

Last night, having missed one of my favourite restaurants in my backyard, I stopped at Hotel Runs, and enjoyed a plate of mutton soup. And as I did it, I looked sideways to see five men toss out breads and meat from the ovens, with each one joking and ribbing the other.

Hotel Runs takes on a character after 9 p.m. Singles, couples and groups are here to have a good meal. And often polish it off with tea or lemon tea. Many people love to end a good day with a big meal; now that's not good for body and mind. But you look into their life and you realise why they all tuck in big late at night.

Jesuit Heritage in San Thome

Francis Xavier, the Jesuit priest arrived in assigned by the King of Portugal to the Jesuits. Goa in May, 1542.

He moved to the Fisheries Coast (Tuticorin side in Tamil Nadu) for some two years, then came to Mylapore in April 1545, where he remained for four months in order to ascertain God's will for his future. Then he decided to set sail to the regions of Malacca.

Legend has it that he prayed at a statue of Mother Mary which is now inside the San Thome Cathedral

The residents of San Thome asked for Jesuits and Xavier, as superior in the Indies, sent them in March 1549, a Spanish priest by name Alfonso Cipriano. He worked in this area until his death in 1559. In 1558, the church of St. Thomas was

as Xavier had wished; but they did not gain possession of it, since the Portuguese canons were opposed to this. The Jesuits therefore built their own church locally.

In 1563 Fr. Francisco de Pina came to San Thome as Cipriano's successor and, until his death in 1581 he was active in San Thome. The annual letter of the Indian Jesuit province for 1575 states that the Jesuits had a house in San Thome which resembled a college and usually had two priests and one brother. It is surmised this college stood close to where the present convent of Bon Secours nuns is located on Madha Church Road.

In 1576 they started an elementary school for children. The church of Our Lady was

completed and meant for the Indians and dedicated on 8 December of that year. This is where the present Madre de Deus Church stands, inside Dhyana Ashram on Madha Church Road, R A Puram.

In 1580, a certain Portuguese, Nuno Alvares de Faria gave to the Jesuits the property of Little Mount of San Thome (Chinna Malai), also known as Monte Calvario, which he had owned for 34 years

In 1598 Fr. Pimenta made his visitation to San Thome, where the Jesuit residence had already been for a long time regarded as a "College" and where the gift of a native prince, the Nayak of Gingee, provided a solid financial foundation, according to the Rector from San Thome, Fr. Simão de Sã. (details are from Fr. Joseph Wicki, the Jesuit historian).

Today, the Jesuits are based in Dhyana Ashram, where lectures, study and other events are held and many priests are in residence.

Vadapalani Andavar Oil Mills

One distinct body of shops on Bazaar Road, which was Mylapore's market hub, and the key link between the villages of Triplicane and Mylapore were the flour and oil mills - oil mills using the chekku.

There must have been some 8 to 10 such places but the most famous was Vadapalani Andavar Oil Mills.

Some two dozen people worked here - so you can imagine its operations - I have seen some 20-plus machines here.

Here, they ground wheat, rice and masalas and also provided oils.

There would be a long queue for these services. Those were days of very few packaged products.

The grinding of shikakai was a tricky job - the blades of that machine had to be changed and so, this grinding was carried out only on one particular day of the week or once in 10 days; which meant that people who needed this, had to give it time and be here on

Till about the 1990s, there existed two mills off Bazaar Road, upgraded with motors but downgraded

Students presented models on themes related to math, physics, chemistry, biology, commerce, economics and social sciences. They took turns to explain the projects to visitors and students.





Seashore residents protest in Pattinapakkam. After man dies in balcony collapse. They want state to act on new housing

Traffic on the busy San Thome High Road was jammed on Thursday as over 100 residents of Srinivasapuram by the seashore staged a protest on the road and blocked traffic flow. bad shape for years now; the state agency in charge has sealed some sections here but every monsoon, parts of flats of roofs collapse. Families continue to reside inside decaying flats.

There have been talks by state agencies to get residents to move out and await new

dwellings when new blocks are built but the process has been delayed. Some say a local group has thwarted the plan since it manages and makes money from renting unauthorised shanty rooms rented to migrants.

Other residents say they are ready to move but have not been given a pucca space

closeby; they do not want to be dumped on the fringes of the city.

There are thousands of people living in illegal huts and houses here and along the Adyar estuarine shore. These people also

And for people who need warm clothes at this time of the year, there are two shops where you can shop for them.

On East Mada Street is Aadhi Silks. Shop here for woollen muf-

flers, shawls, kullas, silk ties, silk scarves and silk stoles.

The prices for mufflers are from Rs. 170 to Rs.210. Prices for shawls



start from Rs. 150. Kullas cost Rs. 55.

Shop owner P. K. Chandrasekar says all of the clothing is in standard sizes. The shop is opposite the 'ther' shed.

Another shop which sells these clothes is Seematti Readymades, a 'bunk' shop on East Mada Street, opposite NAC Jewellers.

Sold here are woollen scarves, ear muffs, kullas, mufflers, gloves and socks besides winter caps and sweaters for children and adults.

Prices for warm clothes for children start from Rs. 25 and go up to Rs.300, said shop owner Mohammed.

Amirda says she too is unsure about the exact location of the project.

The market is obviously meant to accommodate the hawkers of the Pattinapakkam – Srinivaaspuram zone who refused to get into the current mod market.

Asked if the present line of seafood joints that have a thriving business will be relocated there, the councillor said that may well be the case.

Presently, bikes and cars parked alongside the food stalls cause traffic jams on what is a busy road.




"We loved the effort of the artistes and the rasikas on a day like this," said Bhavan's deputy director Venkitachalam after the concert.
