THYAGARAJA ARADHANA: AT THREE VENUES

Thyagaraja aradhana is to be held at various venues in Mylapore to remember the saint and Carnatic music composer, Thyagaraja on his mukti day.

Here are three places where events are happening -

1. Bharatiya Vidya Bhavan, Chennai Kendra is organising an event that is a tribute to saint Thyagaraja on Saturday, January 18 (Bahula Panchami & 178th aradhana day) at its main auditorium at East Mada Street, Mylapore.

This event starts at 10.30 am: "Tribute to Saint Thyagaraja" is the themed concert by Dr. Prameela Gurumurthy and her group of artistes.

At 12.30 pm: prasadam distribution. All are welcome to participate.

2. A unique Thyagaraja aradhana is held in a small street house of Mylapore. At No.12, Mathala Narayanan Street, off North Mada Street.

This year, the aradhana will be held on January 18, 4.30 p.m. onwards.

This event is held in a small drawing room, where the sacred space also has a visual of Thyagaraja, where a small group of people gurus, artistes and students - sit and sing the famed pancharatna kritis of Thyagaraja.

The group is led by guru Yogam Santhanam and her students, by the son of late flautist maestro Dr. N. Ramani, Thyagarajan and by



Rajaraman, a sishya of T. N. Seshagopalan.

Solo singing follows the gosti singing and finally, prasadam is shared. Rasikas are invited to the venue but will have to make do with limited space.

State govt. plans new granite temple for Valluvar in place of old

The Tamil Nadu government has allotted Rs.19 crores to build a new temple dedicated to saint Thiruvalluvar in Mylapore.

It will replace the brick and mortar temple that exists today.

Chief minister M. K. Stalin is expected to lay the foundation stone for the project soon. New shrines for Valluvar and his wife,

Vasuki are to be built.

A well-known sthapati is to be assigned for the project which proposes a single, elevated structure and designed in a manner that highlights the architectural design of a chariot pulled by elephants.

Other plans include a shrine for Valluvar's parents and a large pond with statues of Avvaiyar and Sangam-era greats placed on its banks.

It is believed that the poet-philosopher Valluvar was born under a *illupai* tree at a spot where the temple now stands, in an inner street of Mylapore, off Nattu Subbaraya Street and at the north end of Sri Mundagakanni Amman Temple.



At the close of Day Three of the annual Mylapore Festival (wholly funded by Sundaram Finance), I took a deep breath. The weekend are long days; starting with the kolam, the cookery and the dayakattam contests at three different venues. And you then have to prepare the ground for another long day.

Sundays are the longest because often, the Walks start around 6.30 a.m. as we try to beat the noise of the traffic and let participants free to enjoy a relaxed breakfast at their favourite place.

So back to the end of Day
Three: we say bye to our team of
workers, aides and volunteers and
my colleague and I walk down
one of the inner streets to the
hotel where we reside. Here, food
hawkers are slowly shutting down
their hawker stalls and I spot a
young woman with what looks



like a sports kit bag slung across her back.

She doubles her way to the main road.

The bag's design and size makes me curious.

'This looks like a cricket kit bag...', I suggest to the woman. She smiles.

'It is packed with ear rings and stuff," she tells me.

She is from Kotturpuram. And she is here to sell trinkets at the Festival. Like dozens of others.

Over the past decade (the festival has completed its 21st edition), the Mylapore Festival has encompassed lots of people of the kind who find such street melas just the place to sell their stuff - bangles and ear-rings, scarves and hair-clips, eco-food-stuff and toys and games, bags and shawls and lots more.

They come from all corners and from afar too. From Tiruvallur and Tambaram, from Saidapet and Mint and beyond; they find some space in the inner streets around Sri Kapali Temple and hawk.

These people also make the festival what it has come to be. A people's festival where everybody is welcome and everybody does what they enjoy on an evening out; watch a puppet show, take selfies, buy some ear-rings, sip some coffee, pick up some *keerai* and pack some chappatis for people at home.

These are the people who complete the festival; while we curate the key events, some 40-plus, held across four days on the eve of the Pongal festival.

On the night we wrapped up the 2025 edition and it drizzled in the dew, and I walked back to my hotel, one well-wisher came up and said - "Many, many hawkers must be glad they can go home and have a nice Pongal."

Those words remain with me.

Kolam Contest: my experience over 20 years

My heartfelt gratitude to the Mylapore Festival team; for the team behind the Kolam Contest for providing a wonderful platform to hone my kolam designing skills. I have been an active participant in this contest for nearly two decades.

Being new to Chennai at that time, it was my mother-in-law, a longtime resident of Mandavelipakkam, who introduced me to the event. I vividly remember my first contest in 2005, held in front of what is now Sukra Jewellers on North Mada Street. Back then, my experience with kolams was limited to drawing simple patterns in the puja room as part of a daily ritual, often repeating the same designs.

The scene at the contest was both overwhelming and inspiring. The large turnout of participants, armed with chalk pieces, water bottles, brooms, waste cloths, and kolam powder, left me feeling out of place. Standing there with nothing in hand, I was ready to back out. Nervously, I managed to create a basic 13-pulli ther kolam and was relieved just to complete it without missing a dot.

That first contest marked the beginning of my journey as a kolam artist. Over the years, I began scouting for designs during my leisure time, carefully saving them for future



contests. Today, 20 years later, I feel more confident in my skills, experimenting with different styles and incorporating elements from other art forms into my kolams.

This contest serves as a vibrant cultural platform where artists can meet, showcase their work, and exchange ideas. The excitement is palpable. Kudos to Vincent D' Souza and his team for their tireless and selfless efforts in promoting kolam artistry.

Want to buy rice or dhal or atta at rates that are lesser than those at local stores?

Look for this van that offers you good stuff and at rates that are a deal.

The van is part of a service offered by the National Co-operative Consumers Federation



of India (NCCP) which functions under the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Government of India.

The NCCP has been arranging mobile sales of provisions in all the major areas at rates much lower than the MRP rates in local private stores.

These vans are positioned in strategic locations of Important places in the

In Mylapore, the NCCP mobile van is parked on East Mada Street near Kalathi rosemilk shop everyday, 10 a.m. onwards till 5 p.m.

It offers rice (Rs 34 per kg), dhal (Rs 70 per kg), konda kadalai for Rs 58 per kg and atta for Rs 30 per kg besides other stuff. Payment can be made via GPay too.

The Hindu Lit for Life, The Hindu's annual literature festival will be held on January 18 and 19 at multiple venues in Chennai.

One associate event features multifaceted artists at an exhibition.

And one of the artists is Frenchwoman Chantal Jumel, for whom Mylapore is a second home, for she spends 5 to 8 weeks in the heart of Mylapore, working

out of her base near Sri Kapali Temple and touring India and walking down Mylapore's lanes and streets.

Chantal's work is to be featured at the Lit Fest's Imprint: The Paper and Book Project, curated by Sharan Apparao and Shijo Jacob, which looks at the connections between art and literature.

Chantal said she spent the past four weeks, just before she flew into Chennai to work on a cute work; a work she themed on Mylapore and her experiences here.

On a set of a dozen art paper sheets, cut in the shape of what she playfully calls small *poppadoms*, Chantal employs her technique of puncturing the paper with sharp little holes that form the outline of her images - and in this little booklet the images are kolam, temple ther, flowers and so on.

The two-day festival will be held at Sir Mutha Concert Hall, The Hindu Pavilion, and The Annex (Lady Andal School premises) in Chennai.

The exhibition then moves to a city gallery.





Zoology students at Queen Mary's College study and buy plants that can do this

Butterflies are fascinating insects that play a major role in the ecosystem. They are significant bioindicators and flagship species.

How do you draw butterflies to your garden?

One of the topics that a batch of stu-



dents of Queen Mary's College, Mylapore discussed recently.

As part of Wildlife Week celebrations, the department of zoology, Queen Mary's College, organized a sale of plants which attract butterflies. This event was held in October 2024.

Students were briefed on the plans and then allowed to buy some saplings that could attract butterflies.

Prof. E. Malathi, HoD said that the objective of this event was to encourage students to establish a garden that could attract butterflies.

She says, "The garden need not be a huge space. It could even be a single sapling that could attract butterflies."

Butterflies require both host and nectarine plants. By growing a host plants, students learn to study different species of butterflies that are attracted to these plants to complete their life cycle.

Butterflies are attracted towards vibrant colours.

Nectarine plants such as Ixora, Asters, Hibiscus, Premna, Crotolaria, Nilavembu, Blue bell, Champak, Sweetbasil, Keshavardani and host plants such as curry leaves, lemon, bael, Pongamia, bamboo, false Ashoka, Kalonchi, Petunia, Passion flower, mango, Nerium, Palm, Golden shower tree and Guava were sold.

This was a novel initiative on the QMC campus.

Young talent also find a stage in sabha and private concert hhalls during the famed December Season. And though the audience may be small - family and friends mostly - their talent is there to see. And some of them move up in the concert circuit.

There are teens who move to the heart of Mylapore, from USA or elsewhere, to learn music locally. And when they reach a level, what to perform on stage.

Vidarshanaa Anand is one such young talent, with a lineage that she and her family is proud of.

This flautist will be performing at Lakshmi Giri Convention Hall, North Mada Street, Mylapore on January 11.

This 13-year-old is the great granddaughter of flute maestro late Dr. N. Ramani.

Vidarshanaa's mother, Shanthi Murali and father, Anand Rajaram, are scientists in the US. The family moved to Mylapore so that the girl immersed in music.

"Vidarshanaa's love for the flute and for Carnatic music was a major driving reason for our relocation to Chennai in 2023. We also wanted our girls to learn our culture and tradition. Vidarshanaa showed deep interest in Carnatic music and rhythm ever since she was a toddler," says Shanthi, whose mother, Latha is Dr Ramani's daughter.

Vidarshanaa tells us over phone that her classes in flute started at the age of five when her great grandfather, Dr Ramani, taught her the basic lessons during a brief India trip.

"I continue my learning from Dr Ramani's student, B Gokula Krishnan. I am fascinated with the techniques and nuances of flute playing and I love attending flute concerts from all schools of music," she says. To understand the contrast between Indian and western styles of flute playing, she is also learning Western C flute from Seetha Shivaswamy in Austin, Texas. Though she is currently living in Chennai, she has enrolled in an online school in the US. Vidarshanaa has been learning Odissi classical dance for the last seven years from Aparupa Chatterjee in the US.

Overnight rain on Pongal eve had rendered the inner streets of Mandavelipakkam wet and so people who often draw large Rangolis for the occasion, were discouraged.
