







CHENNAI METRO

Major, multiple traffic changes in Mandaveli, Mylapore, Luz

Major traffic movement changes are expected this weekend in areas like R. K. Mutt Road, Mandaveli, Luz, Mylapore, R. H. Road and Dr Radhakrishnan Salai in connection with Chennai Metro's rail line work.

Over the past 24 hours, Chennai Metro has been sharing details and maps on the major changes with some institutions where there are large numbers of people at work /

In one communication that was shared by a campus, a map showing the major changes has been posted.

One part of the flyover that runs north from Royapettah High Road / off V. M. Street, will be brought down. Hence,

traffic movement off Dr R. K. Salai will be changed.

Since Luz Circle is to be a major arena of work, with two underground stations planned here, traffic will be curtailed on R. K. Mutt Road between the tank zone of Sri Kapali Temple and Luz Circle.

Vehicles will be routed through the inner streets - Warren Road, Dr Ranga Road and Luz Avenue - and these areas are going to be abuzz over the next 2/3 years.

Mandaveli being the arena for an underground station, traffic flow is being diverted here – already many parts have been barricaded now.

Chennai Metro has still not formally, publicly communicated to the neighbourhood the changes on the anvil.



VINCENT'S JOTTINGS

How does a 120-year-old, foldable pallankuzhi set survive in a household?

I must ask its current owner, a resident of Mylapore, that question.

Perhaps, the set survives because it is being taken out often for the seniors to amuse themselves when boredom creeps in; or its owners are proud of retaining family heirlooms.

The pallankuzhi set is one of seven invaluable things that may find a place in an exhibition that the Sundaram Finance Mylapore Festival's 2024 edition will host in early January.

Five years ago, we thought of and executed a similar show at the Sannidhi Street square. We put up 25 things - transistor, cooking vessels, walking stick, cassette recorder, a directory and a book stand and more. The articles fascinated Gen X and we noticed amused parents patiently explaining things to their curious little ones. And we decided to have the exhibition again and call for support from Mylaporeans. (If you wish to share an object, please call our office staff at 24982244)

Why do we choose such ideas for what is, at its core, a street cultural festival that is almost two decades old? To get the community involved in different ways.

Hours before I sat down to pen this column, quilt-maker Varsha wove something more out of a thread I shared as an activity at the Festival. How could we get, say 20 women, who enjoy handwork / stitching / embroidery, to create work of the size of a handkerchief and collect all of those handworks and mesh them into a wall backdrop?

This would be a simple community-driven work of craft that fits well with the spirit of the festival.

Curating the core performances for the Festival is simple and straight. The effort and the challenge is to get people involved in an activity and enrich it from all sides.

I vividly remember the year when we invited a senior, celebrated folk arts master to train the children at the CSI School for the Deaf in San Thome for a short performance on the main stage. The teachers at this school used their familiar modes of communication to train the students and it worked.

We are talking to the small Post Crossers community in the city on ideas that can work for the Festival. First on the board is the creation of a special post card which showcases the Festival and will be released that weekend.

We also have plans for children - they can pick up a specially-designed, blank post card at the venue, use crayons and colouring pens to illustrate a note they can write on the card and have the card posted to their friend or grand-ma, in a box placed at the spot.

We welcome small, community-at-the-core ideas that flow with the spirit of this Festival. Have an idea that you and your friends can collaborate on? Ping us at 24982244.

Recalling Dr. Badrinath's early years

I met Dr. Badrinath at H. M. Hospital in 1969 when I took my father for cataract surgery. My cousin, K R Venkataraman was his first patient. In those days, Dr Badrinath used to give appointments to only four patients per day, maintained a time schedule and never gave preference to VIPs. When I was in his room with my father, the secretary of a well-known personality called the doctor for an appointment. Dr Badri politely refused saying even a former chief minister had to wait for 15 days.

At that moment, a tailor boy who got his eye pierced while stitching buttons came in. Dr Badrinath asked us to wait for some time, took the boy to the operation theatre and performed the surgery. He did not charge any fees from that boy. He charged us Rs 250 for the surgery.

In 1972, I took my father to Dr Badrinath in Vijaya Hospital. He remembered my family members and enquired about them. He charged Rs 250/- for the cataract surgery, this time too.

Tribute to Benjy

Spiralling, sky-rocketing frustration on a hot August afternoon in 2015, a crate in the corner of a noisy airport warehouse with trolleys wheeling past and the roar of planes landing and taking off.

Precious cargo, our little Benjy had landed after two flights from Australia.

Dogs in crates travel on an empty stomach to prevent vomiting which might enter the wind pipe and cause death mid-air.

Six hours and multiple encounters with

bureaucratic depths of apathy, a filthy, tired, hungry and dehydrated Benjy was 'cleared'.

A comfort to many who had lost their pet, a regular feature at the annual Mylapore

Festival, towering over everyone on his dad's shoulder, a temporary companion on cuddle visits to those who loved dogs, Benjy was an extension of us and invitations to us, included him

Benjy sniffed out an injured crow, a hurt squirrel and finally, an injured parrot, a few weeks before he left us. They recovered and regained strength in that infamous crate and left.

Two days after Benjy's passing, we found an

injured crow. Yes, he had taught us well in sniffing out injured beings and helping them recover.

We suspect Benjy was with an elderly person who passed away and left him homeless.

Rescued by RSPCA Toowoomba, Queensland, Australia, we adopted him in 2014 and moved with him to Madras in 2015.

Vets at SKS Veterinary Hospital in R. A. Puram valiantly tried to save his life all night, but our beloved Benjy left us in the early morning of 3rd October, 2023.

His last journey at the BlueCross animal crematorium was on a stretcher that went through horse stables and cow sheds.

Our little Benjy-man had the last laugh - he loved the smell of horses, cows and their poo too!

SWEETS FOR DEEPAVALI

These People Made Goodies at Home

Five Mylaporeans share their experience of making sweets and savouries at home, for Deepavali. V. Soundararani spoke to them.



K. Janaki Abhiramapuram

K. Janaki, 68 years old, is a housewife, and has been making Deepavali snacks for many years - guided by skills and tips shared by her mother-in-law, Saroja Balasubramaniam. Janaki has been living with her mother-in-law since 1975. "She is 88 now and her passion for cooking and food remains. Every Deepavali, it's only homemade snacks for us all these years," she said.

"The proportion of dough for making mixture and then-kuzhal she follows is ideal and unique," said Janaki. "I personally love to make wheat halwa. The process excites me. How the halwa turns out finally is fascinating. We ensure it consumes less ghee!"

She had made halwa, maalaadu, manoharam, mixture and thenkuzhal this year. Janaki lives on 3rd Street, Abhiramapuram.

Anuradha Sivakumar is 65, a housewife and enjoys cooking. When it comes to Deepavali preparations, apart from the routine snacks, she says she tries making new sweets in small

She had prepared rava laddoo rich in nuts, maa laadoo, mixture and chakli this year.

"When we cook at home, we can make sweets in large quantities for the cost one pays for at shops," she says. "And when we do this we can be generous in sharing sweets among friends and relatives."

Anuradha lives on C. P. Ramaswamy Road.

Sandhya R., is an IT professional and she says she makes time for the festival snacks though she has a demanding job. "We never buy readymade snacks. My mom and mother in-law even prepare the lehiyam at home. We make it a point to buy all the raw materials, crackers and other things only from the local vendors to lend them our support," said Sandhya.

Her mother-in-law stays with her and they both adhere to tradition.

So they made ribbon pakoda, murukku, thenkuzhal, milk sweets, peda, rava laddoo and kaju katli this season. "The texture and taste of our milk sweets has won us lots of appreciation," she said.

And she shares a cooking tip: while making gulab jamun, a portion of home-made paneer added to the dough makes a huge difference in taste.

Sandhya is a resident of R. K. Mutt Road, Mylapore.

Karpagam T. retired as a superintendent in the state government's education department and is 74 years old now. "Never ever have we bought snacks from shops," she says. Her family loves crunchy savouries and these are made round the year but there are specials at festival time.

"When we make murukku, light roasting of the flour makes them crunchy and neat," she says.

Preparations here start a week ahead, once the processing of flour is over. Karpagam is careful in her plans - five sweets and five savouries for Deepavali. These are made in the time between preparing food daily for the family. "If we get motivated to process the raw material, the rest of the cooking is easy," she said.

This season, the goodies here included rava laddoo, maa laddoo, halwa varieties and murukku thenkuzhal.

Katpagam resides on T. S. V. Koil Street, Mylapore.

Saraswathi resides in Alamelumangapuram.


3 Obituary

Hours after the passing away of famed ophthalmologist and the founder of Sankara Nethralaya on November 21, **Dr. S. S. Badrinath**, the funeral rites of this Mandavelipakkam resident were conducted at a city crematorium.

The simple, visionary doctor, aged 83, who had been spending the last phase of his life at his residence, had often told his senior colleagues that work at all the Nethralaya centres should go on even in the event of his passing, that patients should be affected.

Dr Badrinath was a vitreoretinal surgeon who started on a mission in 1978, at a 17-bed hospital on College Road, Nungambakkam and converted it, with handsome donations from well-wishers, into a top class eye-care centre that was known across India and abroad.

He did his schooling in the city, completed medical studies at Madras Medical College and studied ophthalmology at a college in the USA. He worked there for some years and on returning to Madras, worked at a few city



impacted early in life by the travails of children with serious eye problems, ensured that a good part of Sankara Nethralaya's services were provided to the poor and people from low-income group,

raising the monies from payments made by patients who could afford the treatment here.

Generous donations from V. D. Swamy, C. U. Shah, Rata Tata and Nani Palkhiwala, among others, enabled the expansion of Sankara Nethralaya under Dr.Badrinath's leadership.

Alongside, the research here provided low-cost treatment procedures and led to new findings in ophthalmology.

Dr Badrimath was highly influenced by the swamis of the Sri Kanchi Mutt; he had operated on Sri Chandrasekarendra Saraswathi-swami.

He was decorated with the Padma Bhushan and the Dr B. C. Roy awards.




